

## **ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY**

PWL overall environmental objective is to design and manage transport and logistics services with the lowest net environmental effects possible.

## To achieve this PWL will:

- 1. Comply with industry related environmental legislation.
- 2. Consider environmental objective planning and management a core business activity and provide adequate resources for environmental management, for environmental enhancement projects, and for relevant research.
- Achieve continuous and demonstrable improvement in environmental performance. Do this through self determination and the interest of all parties involved with PWL.
- 4. Reasonably minimise the adverse local environmental effects that may be an unavoidable effect of operating PWL's business, e.g. freight terminal/depot location.
- Support appropriate both transport and non transport projects that have significant positive effects for the New Zealand environment.
- 6. Train and inform PWL's staff and contractors so that they can fulfil their obligations under the PWL Environment Management Responsibilities.
- Measure and report PWL's performance against its environmental objectives. Do this regularly and consistently with openness and integrity.

## **OBJECTIVES**

- 1. To use the most fuel efficient vehicles available.
- 2. To maintain the PWL fleet of vehicles to a high standard to avoid fuel wastage and pollution.
- 3. To fit aerofoils to vehicles which carry high loads to improve fuel efficiency.
- 4. To fit speed limiters to all new vehicles to improve fuel efficiency.
- 5. To use unleaded petroleum products in company cars.
- 6. To minimise noise levels by restricting the use of engine and/or exhaust brakes.
- 7. To keep the fleet and depot sites clean to further avoid pollution.
- 8. To use air suspensions on vehicles to reduce impact on road surfaces.
- 9. To use recycled materials where/when practicable.
- 10. To use biodegradable products for cleaning and maintenance where practicable.
- 11. To operate PWL's fleet of vehicles in a logistically efficient manner to avoid unnecessary running whilst at the same time avoiding congested and/or heavily populated areas.
- 12. To continue PWL's in-house training program so that all staff act responsibly, safely and with environmental awareness.
- 13. To discipline PWL employees should they neglect their environmental responsibilities.
- To require PWL's subcontractors and suppliers to observe and comply with PWL's environmental policy.
- 15. To use contractors and suppliers which have environmentally responsible practices.
- 16. Make sure that PWL's safety and business management plans are environmentally friendly.
- 17. Make sure that equipment and supplies used in domestic application are environmentally safe.
- 18. To practice environmentally safe disposal of used and unwanted materials.
